Covenant of Mayors Türkiye's main objective is to to facilitate the transition to decarbonized, climate resilient and energy efficient municipalities through local, national and international stakeholder participation, strategic partnerships and information exchange, thus improving public health, increasing sustainable economic impact and contributing to combat global climate change.

Combating Climate Change and Promoting Low-Carbon Development:

Reducing carbon emissions, supporting municipalities in adopting low-carbon development policies, and contributing to a carbon-neutral future.

Enhancing Energy Efficiency and Promoting Renewable Energy:

Increasing energy efficiency and supporting the transition to renewable energy sources within local communities.

Raising Public Awareness and Encouraging Social Participation:

Building awareness on climate change issues and involving local communities in climate action initiatives.

Fostering Collaboration and Knowledge Sharing Among Municipalities:

Encouraging municipalities to collaborate, share experiences, and learn from each other in order to implement effective climate actions.

Providing Access to Funding and Technical Support:


Offering municipalities access to national and international funding opportunities, along with technical support to help them implement their climate action projects.




