



EU4ETTR Project Team Leader Ms. Daiva Matoniene, summarized the Multi-Level Governance Platform (MLGP) for Climate Actions and Towards 100% Renewables in Türkiye. This initiative aimed to propel Türkiye towards a sustainable future amidst climate challenges. The presentation covered its conceptualization, implementation, achievements, and future plans. It emphasized collaborative climate governance, capacity building, and innovative problem-solving.





The presentation outlined a strategic roadmap for nationwide expansion, emphasizing dialogue with stakeholders and funding mobilization. The MLGP represents a transformative model for Türkiye's climate governance, driving progress towards a sustainable, lowcarbon future.



# IRENEC 2024 CLIMATE PANEL

### The Climate Panel Session was followed by more than 100 people!


Dr. Ertuğrul Selçuk Güldüler presented a compelling proposal for sustainable energy transition in Istanbul's Bağcılar Municipality through solar power plants. Backed by meticulous assessments, the project strategically leveraged solar energy to mitigate carbon emissions and meet electricity demands.

Aligned with Bağcılar's Sustainable Energy and Climate Action Plan (SECAP), it aimed to install a 171.72 kWp Solar Power Plant, promising significant environmental benefits and cost savings. Dr. Güldüler's presentation highlighted the project's scholarly approach to energy transition, emphasizing its potential for broader climate change mitigation and sustainable development goals.

Additionally, Dr. Güldüler highlighted the competitive advantage and the potential for Bağcılar to serve as an inspiring example for other regions aiming to embrace renewable energy solutions.







Mr. Arif Künar presented a comprehensive issue at the IRENEC conference and addressed urban energy transformation and the pressing issue of energy poverty. Focusing on İstanbul Metropolitan Municipality's initiatives, particularly Municipal Energy Desks (BEM), Mr. Künar suggested providing information and support to households for energy efficiency improvements and renewable energy adoption. Mr. Künar introduced the "Alo Energy Advisory Desk" (AEDM) and discussed training, operational frameworks, and community engagement strategies. By advocating for collaborative approaches, the speech aimed to alleviate energy poverty and promote sustainable energy transitions in urban areas.







### PROJECT PROPOSAL PREPARATION TRAINING - III 25 April 2024

The third session of training for preparing project proposals brought together Turkish municipalities committed to the Covenant of Mayors initiative.





Attendees gained crucial knowledge on completing project application forms and mastering project budget preparation. With a focus on climate actions, Sustainable Energy and Climate Action Plans (SECAP), and interregional collaboration, the session underscored the importance of proactive engagement in addressing mitigation and adaptation challenges.

Subsequently, participants delved into the Interreg NEXT Black Sea Basin Cross-Border Cooperation Program, an opportunity open to 25 provinces in Türkiye, with an application deadline set for June 28, 2024.



The session commenced with valuable insights into crafting a **Logical Framework Matrix**, recognized as a foundational element for successful project proposals.

Paris Agreement was signed in 22nd of April, 2016.

In 2016, on Earth Day, something epic went down: the Paris Agreement was unleashed for signatures! This game-changer brought together over 190 countries, all pledging to slash carbon emissions and tackle climate change head-on. It's like Earth's Avengers assembling to save the day! With transparency, accountability, and big dreams, this agreement is our ticket to a cooler, greener planet.

### **History of World Day**

Earth Day's story is one of grassroots passion and global impact. It all started in 1970 when Senator Gaylord Nelson rallied Americans, inspired by events like Rachel Carson's "Silent Spring" and a devastating oil spill off Santa Barbara's coast. On April 22nd of that year, over 20 million people took to the streets, demanding action to protect our planet.

Their voices were heard. President Nixon established the EPA, and Congress passed landmark laws like the Clean Air and Clean Water Acts. Earth Day's influence didn't stop at America's borders. In 1990, it went global, sparking action in 141 countries.


