





Example: Galicia



CoM is a common language for meaningful climate actions.

Galicia has seen a remarkable increase in Covenant of Mayors signatories, growing from 22 municipalities in 2019 to an impressive 285 municipalities in just 4 years.

Galicia's secret is explained as the power of **citizen involvement** and the **crucial role of local governments** in achieving climate targets; providing a **common language**, **practical tools**, and a relatable approach, it empowers municipalities to take meaningful climate action as the region coordinators said about the success.


Breaking Barriers: 4 in 5 GCoM Signatories Surpass National Climate Targets, Setting a New Standard for Global Leadership!



Picture this – if we covered half of Europe with trees, that's the same amount of carbon these efforts could take out each year.

GCoM cities and local governments are working hard to cut a huge **5.6 GtCO2** from yearly global emissions by 2050, way more than the usual path.

4 out of 5 GCoM cities are aiming higher than their countries in fighting climate change, and 57% plan to get there faster.






